### 1. HOST CLUBS & DATES

### 2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE & AWARDS

- 2.1. Each competitor shall be under 19 years of age during the series and must be a member of an SCYA or SCYYRA club.
- 2.2. Competitors must enter both the individual regattas and the Hamlin Series. To enter the Series, a competitor must register via the internet at [www.scyyra.org](http://www.scyyra.org). A competitor must enter the series no later than the start of the first race of the second regatta.
- 2.3. There will be a \$30 per person series entry fee payable online to SCYYRA. The Series entry fee includes a series gift for each helmsman and crew.
- 2.4. The helmsman and crew will be scored separately.
- 2.5. Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 places in the Series for helmsman and crew.

### 3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

Competitors (helmsman & crew) must be members in good standing of the 29er Class Association. Membership can be obtained on the North American 29er website at [www.29ernorthamerican.org](http://www.29ernorthamerican.org).

#### 4. RULES

The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020; the prescriptions of US SAILING; the Series Standing Rules as published in the 2018 SCYYRA webpage; the 29er Class Rules as published at [www.29er.org](http://www.29er.org); this Notice of Race; and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club.

#### 5. SCORING

- 5.1. Series scoring shall be based on the official results of each race tabulated only against other Series entrants.
- 5.2. Series scoring shall be in accordance with RRS A4.
- 5.3. For the Series a DNC is defined as not registering for a Series Regatta and shall be scored the number of entries in the Series Regatta plus one.
- 5.4. Ties will be broken using US SAILING Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht ahead in the final race that the two participating yachts both started.
- 5.5. Throw out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:
  - If 10 races are completed, there will be 1 throw out.
  - If 14 races are completed, there will be 2 throw outs.
  - If 18 races are completed, there will be 3 throw outs.
  - If 22 or more races are sailed, there will be 4 throw outs.
- 5.6. Sail number changes must be reported to the Series Chairmen and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.
